### OUR WHITE TEAS

Bai Mu Dan – Fujian Province (China): Bai Mu Dan, literally “White Peony,” is a tea in its natural state with beautiful silvery buds. A delicate aroma with a flavour of fresh hazelnut. €15.00

Rose Nepal – Morocco & Nepal: A subtle blend of rosebuds from Morocco and white tea from Nepal. With fine, vegetal and floral notes from a sustainable cultivation. €18.00

### OUR GREEN TEAS

Sencha Saemidori – Kagoshima (Kyūshū island, Japan): This tea is made with young spring leaves that are lightly steamed (futsūmushi). It has a very fresh, vegetal flavour with a soft feeling. €17.00

Jasmine – Fujian Province (China): A tea vineyard with the essences of three flowers, fresh jasmine enhanced with magnolia and tuberose. €15.00

Genmaicha – Japan: This renowned mix of bancha green tea and toasted rice harmoniously combines fresh, grassy notes with the roasted flavour of the grains. Thirst-quenching, it is ideal with lunch. €12.00

Bancha Hojicha – Japan: The leaves of this traditional tea are roasted in a terracotta pot. A malted flavour somewhere between nuts and cocoa. €10.00

Our teas are sorted by colour from the lightest to the strongest in taste, starting with pure origins, followed by flavoured teas.

Darjeeling Single Tea Estate – Happy Valley (India): *An elegant tea vineyard with small dark amber leaves interspersed with some fluffy buds. Its golden liquor reveals woody aromas.* €10.00

Breakfast T – Ceylon: *A dense and woody blend of Sri Lankan teas with generous, pearly leaves. A wake-up call for your taste buds, served with or without milk.* €10.00

Assam Maijian – Northeastern India: *Honeyed, spicy and natural notes for this golden bud tea. Perfect for a flavourful tea break. Can be enjoyed black or with a drop of milk.* €9.50

Comte Grey – Nepal: *An exploration of a classic tea with accents of bergamot revisited on a woody base like a Darjeeling second flush.* €10.00

Blue of London – Yunnan Province (China): *A fine and delicate Earl Grey flavoured with Calabrian bergamot.* €10.00

Qimen Kao – Anhui Province (China): *A blend of leathery and woody notes from the Keemun red tea with the fermented and flavourful notes of the cacao bark from Congo. Energizing.* €14.00

Smoked T – China: *A new interpretation of this classic, smoked over beechwood to reveal notes of leather and wood. A tribute for Hermès' origins of the saddler and harness-maker.* €12.00
